CHICO

CRESCENT CITY

New Casino, RV Park & Upscale Dining Coming to Crescent City in Spring 2022

Elk Valley Casino is changing the game in Crescent City with a brand-new location for their new 36,000-square-foot ocean view casino, meeting and convention space, and upscale restaurant opening in spring 2022. In addition to 300+ slots and bingo, there will be expanded gaming tables and slots in addition to a new six-table poker room. The new casino will host major live music and entertainment, offer plenty of RV parking spots for overnight stays, and a first-of-its-kind wildlife viewing stand on-site. The elk viewing platform will give visitors an up close glimpse of the Roosevelt Elk herds roaming around the casino grounds. Additional amenities will include over 6,000 square feet of meeting space, EV charging stations, expanded ADA accessible parking and a gift shop. The Elk Valley Rancheria is a federally recognized Indian tribe that is comprised primarily of Tolowa Indians, but also includes members of other local tribes such as Wiyot, Yurok and Hupa.

The Ranch at Death Valley's new **Cottages** officially debuted in February 2022 and are the newest addition to The Oasis at Death Valley's multi-million dollar restoration project. LAGUNA BEACH

HEALDSBURG

Healdsburg Welcomes New Restaurants and Bars

Laura Sanflippo and Tara Heffernon, former Duke Spirited Cocktails' founders, partnered with Chef Sean Raymond Kelley to bring Lo & Behold to downtown Healdsburg in January 2022. The vibrant bar and kitchen serves farm-to-glass cocktails and globally inspired comfort food in a lively and casual environment, utilizing produce from the expansive patio, as well as fruit grown in Heffernon's orchard. SingleThread owners Kyle and Katina Connaughton will introduce a plant-based full-service restaurant, quick-service cafe and wine shop at the former SHED in Healdsburg this March. The project, called Little Saint, is a collaboration with new property owners Jeff and Laurie Ubben, Jenny Hess and designer Ken Fulk. With an à la carte menu inspired by the seasonal bounty of the Sonoma Valley, the restaurant will be open for lunch and dinner with the cafe and retail open daily. Inspired by the idea of creating a local hub for enjoying the greatest wines of the world, former SingleThread directors, Evan and Jade Hufford, in partnership with sommelier and SingleThread alum, Ryan Knowles, will bring a new wine bar to downtown Healdsburg in March 2022 with the opening of Maison Healdsburg. The local wine bar will prominently feature Sonoma Coast wines poured alongside their analogues from Burgundy, as well as champagne, craft sake and beer. Maison Healdsburg will also host private tastings and weekly educational classes catering to both novice drinkers and industry experts.

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LA JOLLA

Marisi Opening in La Jolla Opening Spring 2022

Marisi La Jolla, an inspired new Italian restaurant, will be opening this spring. Led by Executive Chef Chad Huff (Felix Trattoria in Venice, and Broad Street Oyster Co. in Malibu); Culinary Director Erik Aronow (Bouchon Bistro, Red Medicine, Republique, Ink in Los Angeles); Bar & Spirits Creative Director Beau du Bois (Three Michelin-starred The Restaurant at Meadowood); and Dylan Shipsey, a veteran of Union Square Hospitality Group, Marisi focuses on Italian hearth cooking with an emphasis on handmade pastas and classic cocktails. Opening the doors to Italy by way of La Jolla and culling together experience in famed restaurants around the country, the team seeks to break the rules on what guests would expect the best to be. The menu celebrates the rich diversity of cuisine from across Italy, fashioned in a time-honored tradition of handmade pasta all day, every day. The international and highly intense cocktail program features an array of Italian aperitivos, homemade limoncello and more.

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LOS ANGELES

Camphor Now Open in Downtown Los Angeles

Camphor, a modern French bistro, opened in the Arts District in late February 2022. Co-Executive Chefs Max Boonthanakit and Lijo George aim to re-imagine the modern bistro experience by creating a unique flavor identity within the robust Los Angeles dining scene through a cleverly simple yet unassumingly complex menu, with recognizable nods to the duo's South Asian background and classical French training. Camphor's menu includes a shareable feast of small plates, beautifully presented heartier mains, classic cocktails with a twist, and a selection of French and European wines to pair. The 65-seat restaurant has an industrial-meets-clean modern aesthetic, featuring white brick walls, marble tabletops, blue velvet booths, ornate plateware, and an open kitchen with plenty of gold hues and brass accents.

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Gusto Green Now Open

Gusto Green opened to the public in January 2022 in Los Angeles. Helmed by culinary powerhouses Janet Zuccarini (the mastermind behind the "Best Restaurant in America" Felix Trattoria) and Chef Michael Magliano (previously The French Laundry, Quince and Jon & Vinny's Animal) Gusto Green offers plant-forward, omnivore-friendly cuisine with a dedication to sourcing from sustainable, best-in-class purveyors, including an exclusive partnership with Ziese Farms - the only federally approved purveyor of hemp leaf for food. Through this exclusive relationship, Chef Michael Magliano integrates the nutrient-dense leaf in a variety of ways, like Gusto Green's signature amuse-bouche: a crispy, chickpeabattered whole hemp leaf. Highly regenerative and rich in potassium, Omega-3s and more, hemp leaf fits well into Gusto Green's culinary program, which emphasizes high-quality, in-season (and mostly California-sourced) ingredients from progressive local purveyors; shareable plates presented in innovative ways; sustainability; and, as Chef Magliano puts it, "eclectic, healthy dishes that can also be indulgent, crafted with bold, bright, fresh flavors." Guests can also enjoy biodynamic and natural wines, modern cocktails, zero-proof cocktails, housemade kombucha, adaptogenic teas and coffees. A retail component featuring Chef Magliano's housemade hemp goods and picks from the team's favorite local artisans will soon be available as well.

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The Art Room Coming to Downtown Los Angeles in March 2022

Opening at the corner of 9th and Olive, The Art Room is an exciting new restaurant coming to downtown Los Angeles in March 2022. From Chef D. Brandon Walker, the co-founder of The Mar Vista and The MV Grab and Go, this day-to-night café aims to engage its community with art and culture, operating alongside the **AUX Architecture**'s studio and **Seasons LA** art gallery. The Art Room will offer quick and easy options for breakfast and lunch inspired by Chef D.'s old school approach of putting his favorites on the menu regardless of "fit." This means the menu will include anything from his signature tacos to fried okra, mac and cheese, lasagna, fish cakes and spinach fritters. The Art Room will also serve select breakfast items all day, a wide variety of salads, and plenty of plant-based vegetarian and vegan options. With each of his concepts, Chef D. looks to provide a realistic solution to the current labor shortage by creating an employment experience that champions a positive restaurant culture by providing fair pay and worklife balance for its employees. The majority of the culinary team has been working with Chef D. since graduating from his famed culinary training program at the St. Joseph Center – a free program focused on providing training to those who have experienced homelessness, addiction rehabilitation and more.

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MERCED

Chef Quentin Garcia of Rainbird Brings Fine Dining to Merced

Rainbird recently opened in February 2022, bringing an entirely new dining experience to downtown Merced in the El Capitan hotel – a charming JdV by Hyatt historic property - with a thought-provoking five-course tasting menu from Executive Chef Quentin Garcia. The restaurant's name represents the regional bird's unique migration patterns that signal the coming of rain and a forthcoming, bountiful harvest. Serving prix-fixe dinner on Friday and Saturday nights (expanding to host Thursday dinner and an a-la-carte Sunday brunch to follow in the spring), Rainbird's intricate menu is sourced from local and regional farms, epitomizing the vegetable-centric culinary movement within fine dining while encapsulating Chef Garcia's impressive, international culinary training and experimental style. Delicately designed by NICOLEHOLLIS to mimic the earth's natural elements, Rainbird's interiors feature rich natural textures and soft pastoral tones like pale greens, creams and light blues.

MONTEREY COUNTY

New Dining and Drinking Spots in Monterey County

Alvarado Street Brewery is expanding its offering with a new restaurant in downtown Salinas, Alvarado on Main, set to open in spring 2022. The new brewery restaurant will add to the recent revitalization of downtown Salinas and the surrounding area. In nearby Carmel-by-the-Sea, Nicolás Cocina de Herencia is the newest creation from the owners of the beloved Villa Azteca in Salinas. The restaurant's name honors the Alvarez family patriarch and will open in Carmel Plaza in spring 2022. The 5,000-square-foot spot will have indoor dining, bar seating and a small outdoor space, serving specialty Michoacán dishes as well as other Mexican favorites, incorporating three generations of family recipes. Also set to open in spring 2022, Saucy Otter Brewing **Company** is coming to Pacific Grove. This informal spot with a locals' vibe will serve small-batch craft beer in California's last "dry" town, which legalized alcohol in 1969, 30 years after the federal repeal of Prohibition.

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OAKLAND

Chef Paul Canales Opens New French-Inspired Occitania Restaurant in Oakland

Highly acclaimed chef Paul Canales, the chef/owner of Duende and the former long time executive chef of Oliveto, is behind the new French-inspired Occitania, opening in the heart of Oakland's Uptown Arts District in spring 2022. Inspired by the Occitan linguistic region of Southern France which spans from the alpine region of Italy's Piemonte all the way to Spanish Catalonia, the menu blends traditional technique with a modern approach, adapting ancient recipes to showcase local, sustainable ingredients. Rafe Gabel, Italian Wine Specialist and California Appellation Wine Specialist, will oversee operations and the beverage program.

Additional New Restaurant Openings in Oakland

Calabash is a project by Nigel Jones that brings together his Jamaican cuisine with food from Malaysia and northern Iran that he refers to as "a gourmet Whole Foods with a full bar, outdoor dining and lots of grab-and-go items." The restaurant is opening April 2022 on 2302 Valdez Street. Joodooboo is a modern Korean deli from co-chef Steve Joo of pop-up Nokni. The restaurant will focus on house made specialties like tofu, seasonal banchan made with farm fresh ingredients, and simple daily meals to accompany the banchan. Joodooboo opened in January 2022 at 4201 Market Street. Matt Horn of Horn Barbecue recently opened Kowbird, a soul-infused chicken joint with a killer buttermilk fried chicken sandwich - both traditional and sweet and spicy. Kowbird is located at 1733 Peralta Street, and features inventive sauces, Southern-inspired sides and desserts.

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PASO ROBLES

Cane Tiki Room Debuting Summer 2022

The creators of Fish Gaucho, Pappy McGregor's and Eleven Twenty Two Speakeasy are bringing fun, vibrant, tiki vibes to downtown Paso Robles in summer 2022. Inspired by the transition to outdoor dining, Cane Tiki Room will offer a unique food and drink experience where guests can indulge in exotic tiki cocktails paired with chef inspired Polynesian-Fusion small bites, like Kalua pork sliders, ahi poke and spam musubi.

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SAN DIEGO

Coco Maya Slated to Open in March 2022

Coco Maya, by **Miss B's Coconut Club**, is set to open on Little Italy's buzzing India Street in March 2022, offering an open-air aesthetic designed to reflect the boho chic vibes of Tulum, Mexico. Coco Maya's main cocktail bar will sit under a massive skylight and the roof will be removed to create a 900 square foot deck. The restaurant's Caribbean-inspired menus will feature tequila drinks and modern takes on Jamaican coal pot cooking from a Josper Charcoal ovenpowered kitchen.

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SANTA BARBARA

Santa Barbara Urban Wine Trail Reinvents itself in 2022

The Santa Barbara Urban Wine Trail is reinventing itself in spring 2022. Made up of nearly 30 member wineries, many within walking distance of each other and downtown beaches, the trail was founded in 2012 and is California's original urban wine trail. At least four new tasting rooms will open in Santa Barbara and Goleta. Kunin Wines is welcoming a new outdoor Funk Zone tasting room, specializing in natural, unfiltered wines and featuring art nights with neighboring art gallery Silo118. Frequency is moving to a historic courtyard encircled by exquisite Spanish Colonial Revival architecture and lush foliage in the Presidio Neighborhood. La Lieff Wines is opening its first Funk Zone tasting room, featuring the handiwork of highly respected women winemakers Kris Curran and Angela Osborne. Several popular wineries are on the move to new locations in the Funk Zone. including Foley Food & Wine Society, Santa Barbara Winery and Pali Wine Co.

New Eateries and Bars Coming to Santa Barbara

A bumper crop of innovative new eateries and bars are opening in Santa Barbara in early 2022. Known for mouthwatering lobster rolls, Santa Barbara sea urchin and oysters on the shell featured in past pop-ups, Broad Street Oyster Company is opening a permanent location downtown. Bedda Mia will focus on Sicilian cuisine, featuring seafood and fresh produce-forward dishes, plus Sicilian wines. Elaine and Alberto Morello, who own the Olio e Limone eateries, are overseeing the new State Street restaurant. Rare Society, a "retro-swanky" steakhouse, will open a new location in the Funk Zone, owned by San Diego's Trust Restaurant Group. Chef Brad Wise first fell in love with Santa Maria-style barbecue when he met his wife-to-be on a Central Coast road trip. In addition, High Seas Meadery, Wylde Works (maker of jun kombucha and mead) and Augie's Tequila Bar all have plans to open downtown.

FRESNO

Fresno Art Museum Launches Andy Warhol Exhibition

The Fresno Art Museum debuted "Andy Warhol Portfolios: A Life in Pop" in early February 2022. This exhibition includes portfolios and individual prints by Warhol, starting with iconic works from the mid-1960s to the series of monoprints Vesuvius, created in 1985. These prints demonstrate many aspects of Warhol's art, including his brilliance as a colorist, which can be seen in the early Flowers and Sunset series. In later series, Warhol experimented with the silkscreen printing process to create complex surface layers. The exhibit will be on display through June 26, 2022.

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MONTEREY COUNTY

Monterey Bay Aquarium Launches Into the Deep Exhibit in April 2022

Monterey Bay Aquarium's new exhibit, "Into the Deep: Exploring Our Undiscovered Oceans," will illuminate the wonders of Earth's largest living space and most mysterious habitats. The exhibit is a collaborative exhibition developed with the Aquarium's research and technology partner MBARI (Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute), offering an unparalleled descent from the ocean's surface through the dark abyss of the midwater to the seafloor.
